This event is a competition for individuals who have had competition experience and individuals who have never entered a competition before. The event is open to kinders (4-7yrs), primaries (8-9yrs), juniors (10-15yrs) and seniors (16yrs+). When you enter there will be the chance to tick a novice box. This box is to be ticked if the individual has never entered a competition before. Novice categories will be in smaller groups of around four and everyone will receive a medal. Non novice categories will be in the usual BJC weight banded groups and could be of any size, categories may also be merged where safe to do so. This event will run over 3 mats.

Rules and regulations:

- 1) All Judoka must wear a white Judogi (judo suit) compatible to BJC regulations.
- 2) All Judoka aged 17 and under and senior females (females aged 18 plus), must wear a plain white T-shirt to weigh in. Male Judoka aged 18 years and over can choose to wear or not wear a plain white T-shirt during weigh in. Male Judoka (all ages) can also choose to wear or not wear a plain white T-shirt during contest.
- 3) Zori (flip-flops) must be worn to and from the mat area.
- 4) All competitors must have a full BJC or BJA licence.
- 5) Weight allowance will be given for Judogi trousers and for those who wear a t-shirt.
- 6) The Rumble will be run under the latest BJC contest rules.
- 7) **Closing date for entries:** Saturday 6th July 2024.
